# Faith in our Father

Lessons to learn: Luke 15:11-23

Faith in the Father grants access – Luke 15:12, John 16: 23-24, Gal 5:1

1 John 5:14 - *"This is the boldness which we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to His will, he listens to us."*

Haggai 2:8 – "The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine, says the Lord of hosts.

Possession > Prosperity > Prosperity

# Luke 15: 17-18

Faith in the Father produces confidence and action

Faith in the Father brings hope of reconciliation

Rev 22: 17, Luke 15:20

The father has long ago made provision for your reconciliation through his son Jesus. John 3:16



# Luke 15: 22

Faith in the Father brings restoration

Good news – the Father is waiting to restore you to your place of honor and dignity.

2 Corinth 5:21 – “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him”.



# Luke 15: 11-23

Faith in the Father guarantees peace, safety and rest

Matt 11:28 "Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

"My peace I give to you, not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid – Jn 14: 27

When He is in the boat, safety is assured

# How do I maintain my Faith in the Father

- Desire to always be in the company of the Father – Luke 10:42
- Be careful of faith killers – John 20:27
- Ask the Father to help your Faith – Mark 9:24
- Constantly hear and confess his word – Luke 11: 27-28
